There were 30 minute slots for faster/heavier models, slower/lighter/scale models and free flight models, with a corner set aside for rotary stuff (including my micro FPV hovercraft). The day went pretty well, my free flight 'FrankenFlyer' flew well enough to get stuck on a light but was knocked down by a friendly quad flyer. One of the pictures shows a free flight, float equiped triplane doing it's thing and the other shows the pits area. The only downside was the inability of my 'Transistion' flying car to get off the ground, hopefully just a C of G problem after some recent repairs.







The Spotlight Model this month is a Vic Smeed designed Tom Boy built from a Belair short kit and comes courtesy of Rog Robbins who has included a write up (always a bonus).

Covered in Lightspan but not very well. With the battery fitted (35 500mah) the CG came out on the wing trailing edge. Probably due to adding elevator and controls and using a snake for the elevator, so quite a lot of lead installed up

front for a small model. The CG is still at about 40%, if I want to get it any further forward I'll have to find a church roof to rob.
