Always difficult to get a good picture of the pyrotechniques because it's over a reasonably large area. A Bearcat and Skyraider are getting in under the 'flak' (rockets) here.





The Spotlight model for this month is Jon's Polaris. The first Polaris Club Build model to be finished and flown. With additional features such as the battery hatch opening device and the 'reinforced' motor pod. Jon has used a combination of coloured tape and paint to complete the colour scheme. Also, as the rear fuselage bottom is only taped on, the servos and receiver are still accessible.

For those also building a Polaris from the plans, or wanting to try building with Depron type foam, B&Q sell packs of eight, 800mm x 600mm sheets in 3mm, 6mm and 9mm thicknesses. It's called Diall Extruded Polystyrene Board and the 6mm pack I bought cost £16.55. It's worth checking B&Q's website to see if there's any in your local branch though.



I'm still looking for suitable foamboard and blue foam alternatives so if anyone knows what and where please pass it on.

Finally, a reminder that this Sunday is the Midland Area Fly-In at Buckminster. It's usually a good day out. The pilots brief is at 9:30am, flying starts at 10am. All types af model are welcome, but only on 2.4Ghz (can't take my parawing this year). Free tea and coffee is available but please bring your own food.
