Quite a busy meeting this month, being our AGM. Sausage butties and chips were supplied part way through to keep our strength up as we discussed Club fees, changes to the constitution and the ever popular election of Club Officers.

Firstly Club membership fees. With the potential for a difficult year ahead of us (more later) an 'across the board' increase of £10 on Club fees was voted for. So, for 2024, a Senior member is £98, a Veteran member is £88 and a Junior member is £65, all plus BMFA membership fees. Two changes to the Club Constitution were made. The first was a name change, an 'Associate Member' will now be called a 'Family Member' (partner or spouse of paying member, non-flying with no voting rights). The second change agreed upon was the introduction of an 'Honorary Member'. The Committee can vote to award an Honorary Membership to a member of special merit (similar to a BMFA Honorary Membership). An Honorary Member will have full voting rights and will not be required to pay membership fees.

There was also one Rule change, again, a wording change to match the Constitution. 'Guest Members' are now known as 'Temporary Members' and do not need to be BMFA members but must have equivalent insurance.

Club Awards. This year the prestigious 'Mole Reduction Agent' award went to Steve Mason for continuing to keep the pesky blighters at bay even though they've been trying hard. Congratulations Steve, and apologies for being a fraction slow with my camera.

Although I was not available for the culmination of our hotly contested FunFly League, results were kindly taken for me and the eventual winner was Mark Eggleston. Congratulations Mark. You should know that Simon was only one point behind you and Rog came in a close third. I'm sure there were undoubtedly a number of people who deserved it, but the Committee chose to award the Coleman Trophy to yours truly for my continued Newsletter ramblings. My humble thanks to all concerned, especially the photographer who was a lot better than me'.

Alan Brain is co-ordinating the effort so please contact him (or this Newsletter) if you come up with something. We will probably have to make a Change of Use application and become a bit more 'official' to qualify for some funding options. This will most likely be the main topic for discussion at the Club meeting on Jan 3rd so it will be worth attending.
