This month's Spotlight Model has been seen by most, mainly because of it's undercarriage failure during it's first take-off attempt. The model is a Hobbyking Spitfire 60 with a 65" wingspan and intended for a .60 2 stroke glow engine. I bought it at a Buckminster swapmeet from the BMFA stand simply because it came with a suitable electric motor, 100A ESC, servos and electric retracts and, more importantly, was very cheap. When I rebuilt (and strengthened) the undercarriage, a second attempt proved that the recommended aileron throws were about twice what they should be. It's currently running on a 5 cell, 5000mAh LiPo pushing out 860W with a 14x8.5 prop, which is just about enough for the 9.5lbs it weighs. Although the shape is, at best, sport scale, the paint scheme is genuine, from a Spitfire captured early in the war.
