This month's Spotlight Model is the replacement for my Bixler 1 in the shape of a Bixler 3. I managed to buy it as a kit instead of the RTF version for an 'I've got to get that' price, which meant I didn't have to rebuild the Mk1 after it's recent 'incident' (I still rebuilt it, but as a pure slope soarer). It's been fitted out with my Eagle Tree Vector flight controller and FPV kit and retained the same motor as the Mk1, now with the supplied 8x4

prop intead of the 7x5 I was running. The test flight was encouraging, happily pootling around on half throttle, but the stabilization kit wasn't tested due to me not having set it up properly yet.
